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Tutoring

Daytime Tutoring

The Communities In Schools of Auburn site coordinator, provides academic interventions for students, 6th through 8th grade, upon referral from their classroom teacher.

One-on-One

We recruit community volunteers to work with students one-on-one after school for an hour a week Monday through Thursday upon referral from school staff.

Study Hub

Two afternoons a week students can receive homework help, tutoring and a quiet space to study with support from the site coordinator. Tuesdays and Thursdays at 2:15-3:15.

Middle school students have the opportunity to work with kindergarten students at nearby Terminal Park Elementary School from 3:10pm-4:10pm. Peer tutors are asked to come twice a week to help younger students with reading skills.
