## Tutoring

### Daytime Tutoring

The Communities In Schools of Auburn site coordinator provides academic interventions for students upon referral from their classroom teacher.

### One-on-One

We recruit high school and community volunteers to work with students one-on-one after school for one hour on Tuesday and Thursday upon referral from school staff.
