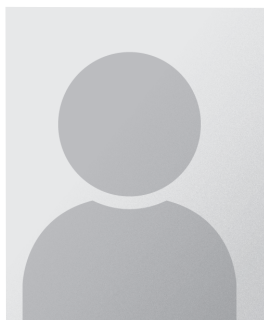

### Daytime Tutoring

The Communities In Schools of Auburn site coordinator, provides academic interventions for students, 6th through 8th grade, upon referral from their classroom teacher.
